

An occupational therapist is reading a patient's history and notes the patient sustained a traction injury to the upper brachial plexus (Erb's palsy) as a newborn. What nerve levels does this involve?

- C3 and C4

An occupational therapist works with the new foster mother of a two year-old child diagnosed with major development delay and severe hypotonia. The OTR advise the foster mother that the best position to put the child in during feeding is with the head in midline while:

- Sitting with hips and knees at 90 degrees flexion, neck in extension
